An individual may not make contributions to a candidate in support of the candidacy of one person aggregating more than \$500 \$1,000 in any election for a gubernatorial candidate or more than \$250 in any election for any other candidate. This limitation does not apply to contributions in support of a candidate by that candidate or that candidate's spouse or domestic partner.

11 12 13 14	2. Committees; corporations; associations. A political committee, political action committee, other committee, firm, partnership, corporation, association or organization may not make contributions to a candidate in support of the candidacy of one person aggregating more than \$500 \$1,000 in any election for a gubernatorial candidate or more than \$250 in any election for any other candidate.

17 18	This bill raises the contribution limit to \$1,000 for a gubernatorial candidate and other candidates.
