
Amend the amendment by striking out all of the first paragraph after the title (page 1,

(page 1, line 29 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "paid" the following: 'for plan
years' '

access payments apply to claims paid for plan years beginning on or after the date the

The decrease in 2009-10 Dirigo Health Fund revenue from the delay in access payments will depend on the mix of plan year start dates after September 1, 2009. Such a delay in the access payments could also delay the Dirigo Health Fund's ability to repay the balance of General Fund borrowing.
