11 Amend the amendment in the 3rd indented paragraph after the title in the last 2 lines
12 (page 1, lines 22 and 23 in amendment) by striking out the following: "property that lies
13 within 1,320 feet of the intended spray area" and inserting the following: 'abutting
14 property'

15 SUMMARY

16 This amendment clarifies that a land manager intending to apply pesticides must
17 notify residents and managers of buildings on abutting property.
