1	*,	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2		Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3174-G, sub-§4 is enacted to read:
3		4. Exclusion. Notwithstanding subsection 1 or any other provision of law to the
4		contrary, a person who is employed by the State on a full-time basis is not eligible to
5		receive services pursuant to this section.
6		SUMMARY
7		This bill provides that full-time employees of the State are not eligible to receive services under the laws governing the MaineCare program.
