COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 912, L.D. 1309, Bill, "An Act To Clarify the Use of Instant Redeemable Coupons with Alcoholic Beverages"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §708 in subsection 1 in the 5th line (page 1, line 9 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "A" and inserting the following: 'A Except as provided by this section, a'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §708 in subsection 7 in the first line (page 1, line 31 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "manufacturer" the following: 'or supplier'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §708 in subsection 7 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 33 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "product" the following: 'as approved by the commission'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §708 in subsection 7 in the last line (page 1, line 37 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "manufacturer." the following: 'Instant redeemable coupons attached to spirits sold to on-premise retail licensees by reselling agents are for the benefit of the on-premise retail licensee.'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §708 in the first indented paragraph in the 2nd line (page 1, line 39 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "merchandise in" the following: 'or on'

SUMMARY

This amendment makes a technical correction to the bill and clarifies that coupons attached to spirits sold by reselling agents to on-premise retail licensees are for the benefit of the on-premise retail licensee.
