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

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 928, L.D. 1324, Bill, "An Act To Adopt the Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunity for Military Children"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §20108 in subsection 1 in paragraph D in the 2nd line (page 7, line 3 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "government" the following: 'The Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate jointly shall appoint the representative of the legislative branch, who may not be a Legislator. The expenses of this representative must be paid using existing budgeted resources of the Legislative Council'

SUMMARY

This amendment requires the representative of the legislative branch to the state council to be appointed jointly by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives, prohibits the representative from being a Legislator and requires the expenses of that representative to be paid using existing budgeted resources.

Legislative Cost/Study

Legislative Cost/Study

This amendment reduces the cost of the bill by prohibiting a Legislator from serving on the state council. The cost of the bill as amended is projected to be \$200 annually beginning in fiscal year 2009-10. The Legislature's budget includes \$10,000 annually in fiscal year 2009-10 and in fiscal year 2010-11 for legislative studies. Whether the amounts are sufficient to fund all studies will depend on the number of studies authorized by the Legislative Council and the Legislature.
