HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 931,
L.D. 1327, Bill, "An Act To Update Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency
Management Laws"

Amend the amendment in section 7 in §536 by striking out all of subsection 4 (page
1, lines 32 to 35 and page 2, lines 1 and 2 in amendment) and inserting the following:

'4. Confidentiality. For the purposes of Title 1, section 402, proceedings and
records of the team are confidential and are not subject to disclosure under any state law,
subpoena, discovery or introduction into evidence in a civil or criminal action and must
be sealed. The chair of the commission shall disclose statistical information and
conclusions of the team upon request but may not disclose the materials that are
otherwise confidential.'

SUMMARY

This amendment makes clarifying changes to Committee Amendment "A" regarding
confidential records of the Case Review Team of the Commission to Protect the Lives
and Health of Members of the Maine National Guard.
