For the purposes of Title 1, section 402, proceedings and records of the team are confidential and are not subject to disclosure under any state law subpoena, discovery or introduction into evidence in a civil or criminal action and must be sealed. The chair of the commission shall disclose statistical information and conclusions of the team upon request but may not disclose the materials that are otherwise confidential.'
