20 21	Amend the resolution by striking out all of the question (page 2, lines 19 to 21 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

25 26 27 28 29	This amendment is the minority report of the committee. It strikes from the resolution the increase in the signature requirement for a people's veto and the requirement that a direct initiative be limited to one subject. It changes the signature requirement for a direct initiative to 15% of the votes cast in the last gubernatorial election. It also changes the question to be printed on the ballot.
