1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	CONCEPT DRAFT
3	SUMMARY
4	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
5	The purpose of this bill is to give a consumer-owned water utility the authority to
6	decrease its rates or to increase its rates between 3% and 5% without the changes being
7	subject to investigation and suspension by the Public Utilities Commission before the
8	changes go into effect. However, the increase or decrease in rates may not be more than
٥	a total of 10% during a 5 year period
