HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 964, L.D. 1374, Bill, "An Act To Ensure the Effectiveness of Critical Incident Stress Management Teams"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §4202 in subsection 1 in the last line (page 1, line 31 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "may" and inserting the following: 'must'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §4202 in subsection 1 in the last line (page 1, line 31 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "only" and inserting the following: 'and may not be made available for any other purpose'


Amend the bill in section 1 in §4202 in subsection 2 by adding at the end a blocked paragraph to read:

Information disclosed under this subsection is no longer confidential unless it is otherwise designated confidential by statute.'

SUMMARY

This amendment makes 2 changes to the bill. The first change specifies that statistical data not identifying a person seeking the assistance of a critical incident stress management team must be made available for statistical evaluation and may not be made available for any other purpose. The 2nd change specifies that any information required to be disclosed under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 25, section 4202, subsection 2 is no longer confidential unless it is otherwise designated confidential by statute.
