A person who has indicated on a valid freshwater fishing license issued under Part 13 that the person engaged in saltwater recreational fishing during the prior year or plans to engage in saltwater recreational fishing during the period covered by the freshwater fishing license. The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall provide this data to the federal or state agency responsible for monitoring saltwater recreational fishing at a time and manner as determined by that agency.'

24 25 26 27 28 29	This amendment exempts a person from the saltwater recreational fishing registry if that person indicates on a valid fishing license that the person engaged in saltwater recreational fishing during the prior year or plans to engage in saltwater recreational fishing during the period covered by the license. It also directs the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to provide this data to the federal or state agency responsible for monitoring saltwater recreational fishing at a time and manner as determined by that agency.

Current biennium revenue decrease - Other Special Revenue Funds

## Fiscal Detail and Notes

Exempting individuals who possess a valid freshwater fishing license issued by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife from the saltwater fishing registry will result in a decrease in Other Special Revenue Funds to the Department of Marine Resources. There is currently no data available to estimate the number of individuals to whom this exemption may apply, therefore no estimate of the revenue decrease can be made at this time.
