COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1013, L.D. 1461, "Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Portions of Chapter 3: Maine Clean Election Act and Related Provisions - Matching Funds and Property and Equipment, a Major Substantive Rule of the Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 19 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "authorized" the following: 'if the rule regarding the minimum amount that must be received from the resale of property and equipment purchased using Maine Clean Election Act funds is reduced from 75% to 40%'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment directs the Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices to adopt the provisionally adopted rules governing the Maine Clean Election Act on the condition that the rule governing the minimum amount that must be received from the resale of property and equipment be reduced from 75% to 40%.
