Correctional and Judicial Impact Statements

The collection of additional fines may increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$6,815 and a Highway Fund allocation of \$6,547 in fiscal year 2009-10 and \$6,887 and \$6,617 respectively in fiscal year 2010-11 to the Department of Public Safety. This amount is based upon an estimate of 400 hours of overtime per year within the State Bureau of Investigation to process additional criminal background checks. General Fund revenues will increase by \$84,000 beginning in fiscal year 2009-10 and Other Special Revenue Funds by \$3,000 beginning in fiscal year 2009-10 for fees related to an increased number of criminal background checks processed by the Bureau.
