- COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1022, L.D. 1468, Bill, "An Act Regarding the Evaluation of Economic Development Programs"
- Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:
- 'Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the comprehensive economic development evaluation has a reporting deadline of February 1, 2010; and

Whereas, it is essential to begin the evaluation process by the beginning of July in order to meet the statutory reporting deadline; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

24 'Sec. 12. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

- 27 Maine Economic Development Evaluation Fund Z057



Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes ongoing Other Special Revenue Funds allocations totaling \$130,000 per year beginning in fiscal year 2008-09 to the Department of Economic and Community Development. Of that amount, the Research and Development Evaluation Fund will receive Other Special Revenue Funds allocations of \$80,000 per year beginning in fiscal year 2008-09 to reflect the increase in the amount that may be collected from agencies and privates entities who received General Fund appropriations or general obligation bonds for research and development Evaluation Fund will receive Other Special Revenue Funds, the Economic Development Evaluation Fund will receive Other Special Revenue Funds allocations of \$50,000 per year beginning in fiscal year 2008-09 to reflect the increase in the annual comprehensive research and development evaluation.
