Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment will result in less of a revenue reduction to the General Fund of \$215,221 and the Local Government Fund of \$11,327 in fiscal year 2010-11. As amended, the bill will reduce General Fund revenue by \$197,695 in fiscal year 2010-11 and reduce transfers to the Local Government Fund by \$10,405 in fiscal year 2010-11.
