Plan to provide Maine veterans free access to state parks. 18 Resolved: That the Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management and the Department of Conservation, referred to in this resolve as "the departments," shall 19 20 jointly review options available for providing Maine veterans free admission to state 21 parks. The departments shall consider all feasible options and develop protocols to 22 efficiently allow veterans free admission to state parks; and be it further 23 Sec. 2. Report. Resolved: That the departments shall report to the Joint Standing 24 Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry no later than January 15, 2010 25 regarding the options considered and protocols developed under section 1 including 26 findings, recommendations and draft legislation necessary to provide Maine veterans free 27 admission into state parks. The Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation 28 and Forestry may submit legislation to the Second Regular Session of the 124th 29 Legislature regarding free admission to state parks for Maine veterans.' 30 **SUMMARY** 31 This amendment is the minority report of the committee, replaces the bill with a 32 resolve and changes the title. It directs the Department of Defense, Veterans and 33 Emergency Management and the Department of Conservation to jointly review options 34 available for providing Maine veterans free admission into state parks. It requires the 35 departments to report their findings, recommendations and any draft legislation to the
