18 19 20 21 22 23	This amendment requires a buyer of a single-family dwelling or a multiapartment building to install smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors within 30 days of acquisition or occupancy of the dwelling, whichever is later, if smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors are not already present.
