11 12	Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:
13 14	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
15 16 17	Whereas, the Caribou Utilities District needs immediate authority to contract with persons inside and outside the district to provide for disposal of sewage and commercial and industrial wastewater; and
18 19 20 21	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
22	Amend the bill by adding before the summary the following:
23 24	'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation takes effect when approved.'

26 27 28 29	This amendment adds an emergency preamble and emergency clause to the bill to ensure the Caribou Utilities District has necessary authority immediately to contract with persons inside and outside the district to provide for disposal of sewage and commercial and industrial wastewater.
