HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1094, L.D. 1552, Bill, "An Act To Improve Employment Opportunities for Maine Workers in the Forest Industry"

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph A in the last line (page 1, line 14 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "section 581" the following: 'for the property tax year in which bonded labor is used'

Amend the bill in section 4 in subsection 4 in the next to the last line (page 2, line 12 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "classification" the following: 'for the property tax year in which bonded labor is used'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the loss of eligibility for classification under the Maine Tree Growth Tax Law is for the property tax year in which bonded labor is used.
