SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 599, L.D. 1562, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Motor Vehicle Laws"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 31 the following:

'Sec. 32. 29-A MRSA §2486, sub-§2, as amended by PL 2009, c. 213, Pt. YYYY, §3, is further amended to read:

2. Allocation of fee. A reinstatement fee paid for a court-ordered suspension under section 2605 and 2608 must be deposited equally between the Highway Fund and the General Fund. ~~Except for suspensions under section 2605~~ For all other suspensions, 85% of the reinstatement fee paid pursuant to subsection 1 accrues to the Highway Fund and 15% accrues to the General Fund.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the reinstatement fee for a suspension for failure to appear, answer or pay a fine for a traffic infraction be deposited equally between the Highway Fund and the General Fund.
