HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1102,  
L.D. 1565, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Laws Governing the Knowing Misclassification  
of Construction Workers"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 5 by inserting after paragraph D the  
following:

'E. Any payment or performance bond issued on or in relation to a construction  
project subject to a stop-work order may not cover any exposure arising out of or  
during the shutdown of that project.'

SUMMARY

This amendment protects an issuer of surety bonds from liability when a payment or  
a performance bond is required of a hiring agent or construction subcontractor and that  
hiring agent or construction subcontractor is subject to a stop-work order from the  
Executive Director of the Workers' Compensation Board.
