17 18 19 20	This amendment protects an issuer of surety bonds from liability when a payment or a performance bond is required of a hiring agent or construction subcontractor and that hiring agent or construction subcontractor is subject to a stop-work order from the Executive Director of the Workers' Compensation Board.
