

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1103, L.D. 1566, Bill, "An Act Relating to the Membership of the Workers' Compensation Board"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 1 in the last blocked paragraph in the last 2 lines (page 2, lines 8 and 9 in amendment) by striking out the following: "A member representing management or labor may not serve for more than 2 full terms." and inserting the following: '~~A member representing management or labor may not serve for more than 2 full terms.~~'

SUMMARY

This amendment, like the bill, relates to the membership of the Workers' Compensation Board. Current law restricts the term of a member representing management or labor to 2 full terms. This amendment repeals that restriction.
