SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1113, L.D. 1575, Bill, "An Act To Establish a Residential Wood Stove Replacement Fund"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the 2nd indented paragraph after the title the following:

'Amend the bill in section 1 in §610-D in subsection 2 in paragraph C in the last line (page 1, line 16 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "fund." the following: "This paragraph is repealed January 1, 2012."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2 and inserting the following:

**Sec. 2. Report.** The Department of Environmental Protection shall submit a report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over natural resources matters on the status and account activity of the residential wood stove replacement program, as established by the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 38, section 610-D, by January 1, 2012.

**Sec. 3. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and allocations are made.

#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment replaces the ongoing Other Special Revenue Funds allocation to the Department of Environmental Protection of \$2,500,000 with a one-time allocation of \$250,000 and adds an allocation to the Federal Expenditures Fund of \$2,000,000 in fiscal year 2010-11 for the residential wood stove replacement program.
