23 24 25 26 27	This amendment replaces the bill and increases from an amount not to exceed \$50 to an amount not to exceed \$150 the civil penalty that a court may order be paid to the holder of a bad check by a person liable for the check. This penalty, in addition to reasonable attorney's fees, may be imposed by the court when the person liable does not pay the amount of the check, plus costs and interest, before the hearing.
