SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 615,
L.D. 1650, Bill, "An Act To Amend Certain Provisions of Fish and Wildlife Laws"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:

Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, this legislation amends the laws governing the training of dogs to hunt; and

Whereas, it is necessary that these changes take effect before the beginning of open training season on July 1st; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,''


Amend the amendment by inserting after section 6 the following:

'Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation takes effect when approved.''

This amendment adds an emergency preamble and emergency clause to the bill.
