16 17	Whereas, this Act is intended to protect the confidentiality of personal information submitted to the State; and
18 19 20 21	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
22	Amend the amendment on page 2 by inserting after section 5 the following:
23 24	'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation takes effect when approved.'
