Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment will increase the total State and local cost of K-12 public education by approximately \$165,000 per year beginning in fiscal year 2011-12. The State's share of that cost is estimated to be \$90,750 assuming the State contributes 55% of the total cost of K-12 public education beginning in fiscal year 2011-12.

This amendment will have no net effect on General Fund appropriations and revenue and a balanced budget is maintained for the 2010-2011 biennium.
