SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1192, L.D. 1691, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Laws Governing Taste Testing of Alcoholic Beverages by Retail Licensees"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in paragraph N in the 2nd line (page 1, line 16 in amendment) by striking out the following: "sale," and inserting the following: 'sale and'

Amend the amendment in section 1 in paragraph N in the 3rd and 4th lines (page 1, lines 17 and 18 in amendment) by striking out the following: "and are at least 20,000 square feet in retail space"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of sections 2 and 3.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the provisions relating to wine retailers and malt liquor retailers. It also removes the requirement that an agency liquor store that is a full-service grocery store be a certain size in order to be subject to the provisions regarding where in the store taste-testing activities must be conducted.
