#### **SUMMARY**

This amendment decreases the fees for competency testing of nursing assistants from
\$55 in the bill to \$45.

This amendment also eliminates one Office Assistant II position from the Department of Education and transfers the position to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Licensing and Regulatory Services. It establishes one Social Services Program Specialist II position in the Division of Licensing and Regulatory Services

### **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

Provides an appropriation of \$88,958 in 2010-11 for the costs of one Social Services Program Specialist II position established in the Division of Licensing and Regulatory Services to align the functions of the Certified Nursing Assistant Educational Programs within one department. Also assumes a net increase in General Fund undedicated revenue of \$74,185 in 2010-11 from increasing the fee charged for competency testing from \$20 to \$45 and for the letter of verification of completion of a certified nursing assistant program from \$10 to \$20.

This bill includes a Federal Expenditures Fund deallocation of \$52,015 in fiscal year 2010-11 to the PK-20 Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment program within the Department of Education due to one vacant Office Assistant II position being eliminated as a result of the responsibilities related to the certification of activities coordinators and Certified Nursing Assistants being transferred from the Department of Education to the Department of Health and Human Services.
