HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1206,
L.D. 1705, Bill, "An Act To Align the Duties of School Boards Concerning Student
Safety with the Requirements of the Federal Gun-Free Schools Act and To Prohibit the
Discharge of Firearms within 500 Feet of Public and Private School Properties"

Amend the amendment in section 3 in subsection 2 by inserting after paragraph B the
following:

'C. The prohibition on possession and discharge of a firearm does not apply to a
person possessing a firearm at a school-operated gun range or a person discharging a
firearm as part of a school-sanctioned program at a school-operated gun range if the
gun range and the program are authorized by a written policy adopted by the school's
governing body.'

SUMMARY

This amendment incorporates the substance of House Amendment "A" to Committee
Amendment "A" except that it clarifies that the school-operated gun range and the school-
sanctioned program must be authorized by a written policy adopted by the school's
governing body.
