4 5 6	Notwithstanding section 924, subsection 3, the county commissioners of Yor County may use revenue generated from boarding prisoners in the county jail in Yor County for any county expense. The county commissioners shall use money from the
7 8	budget of the county jail in York County to pay the cost of payroll expenses for administrative services that are properly allocated to the county jail in York County.

10	§939. Debt service for county jail in York County
11 12	The county commissioners of York County shall pay the cost of debt service for the county jail in York County from the budget of the county jail in York County.

14 15 16	This bill provides that the county commissioners of York County may use revenue generated from boarding prisoners in the county jail in York County for any county expense. It requires the county commissioners to use money from the budget of the

It requires the county commissioners of York County to pay the cost of debt service for the county jail in York County from the budget of the county jail in York County.
