HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1274,  
L.D. 1786, Bill, "An Act Regarding Energy Infrastructure Development"

Amend the amendment on page 8 by inserting after the first indented paragraph the following:

'Amend the bill in Part A in section 2 in §122 in subsection 6-A in the last line (page 11, line 10 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "9." the following: 'Notwithstanding this subsection, revenues generated from the use of land and assets, including but not limited to rights-of-way, owned by the Department of Transportation within energy infrastructure corridors must be deposited in a dedicated account in the Department of Transportation to be used exclusively for highway capital projects.'

Amend the amendment on page 11 by inserting after section 8 the following:

'Sec. A-9. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

TRANSPORTATION, DEPARTMENT OF  
Highway and Bridge Capital 0406

Initiative: Provides an allocation to establish an account for highway capital projects funded from revenue received from the use of land and assets owned by the Department of Transportation.


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**SUMMARY**
