
HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1284, L.D. 1796, "Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Chapter 881: Fees; Chemical Use in Children's Products, a Major Substantive Rule of the Department of Environmental Protection"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in the 4th line (page 1, line 19 in amendment) by striking out the following: "February 1, 2013" and inserting the following: 'December 15, 2012'

Amend the amendment in section 2 in the next to the last line (page 1, line 27 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "bill" the following: 'by April 30, 2013'

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the date by which the Department of Environmental Protection must submit a report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over natural resources matters from February 1, 2013 to December 15, 2012. The amendment also sets a date by which the committee may submit a bill to the First Regular Session of the 126th Legislature of April 30, 2013.
