HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 706,
L.D. 1801, Bill, "An Act To Promote the Establishment of Innovative Schools"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title and before the first indented paragraph the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency preamble.'

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 1 the following:


'Sec. 2. Dissolution of Otis-Mariaville Union School authorized.
Notwithstanding the provisions of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, chapter 109 and any other provision of law, dissolution of the Otis-Mariaville Union School is governed by the Otis-Mariaville Union School Agreement made in 1985, and a majority town meeting vote by the voters of either the Town of Otis or the Town of Mariaville is sufficient to terminate the Otis-Mariaville Union School Agreement in accordance with the terms of the agreement.

Amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency clause.'

SUMMARY

This amendment incorporates the substance of House Amendment "A" to Committee Amendment "A," Filing No. H-800, and also removes the emergency preamble and emergency clause from the bill.
