23 24 25 26 27 28 29	This amendment decreases the amount of the bond request for the Safe Drinking Water Revolving Loan Fund and the Wastewater Treatment Facility State Revolving Loan Fund by \$6,400,000. The amendment also specifies that the \$3,500,000 of the bonds to be awarded on a competitive basis for a community-based teaching clinic affiliated with or operated by a college of dental medicine may not be issued before July 1, 2010 and the \$1,500,000 of the bonds to be used to upgrade community-based health care clinics may not be issued before July 1, 2011.
