HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 12,
L.D. 20, Bill, "An Act Designating March 29th Vietnam Veterans Day"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'Resolve, To Recognize Vietnam Veterans'

Amend the bill in the emergency preamble by striking out all of the 2nd Whereas paragraph (page 1, lines 3 and 4 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

'Whereas, the United States Department of Defense has begun a project to pay tribute to Vietnam veterans and the 50th anniversary of the Vietnam War; and

Whereas, to provide the State with adequate time to pay an appropriate tribute to Maine's Vietnam veterans, this legislation needs to take effect immediately; and'

Amend the bill in the last Whereas paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "therefore," the following: "be it"

Amend the bill by striking out the enacting clause and section 1 (page 1, lines 9 to 16 in L.D.)'

Amend the amendment in section 2 in the first line (page 1, line 12 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Sec. 2. Fiftieth anniversary program. The" and inserting the following: 'Sec. 1. Fiftieth anniversary program. Resolved: That the'

This amendment amends Committee Amendment "A" to strike that section of the bill that designates March 29th as Vietnam Veterans Day.
