
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 13, L.D. 21, Bill, "An Act To Exempt from the Sales Tax Meals Provided at Retirement Facilities"

Amend the bill in section 4 in paragraph G in the first line (page 1, line 15 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "when" the following: 'participation in the meal program is a condition of occupancy or'

Amend the bill in section 4 in paragraph G in the 2nd line (page 1, line 16 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "included in" the following: 'or paid with'

SUMMARY

This amendment specifies that the sales tax exemption in the bill applies only when participation in the meal program is a condition of occupancy of the retirement facility or the meal program is paid for as part of a comprehensive fee.
