SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 28,
L.D. 35, Bill, "An Act Relating to Concealed Firearms Locked in Vehicles"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §600 in subsection 1 in the first line (page 1,
line 15 in amendment) by striking out the following: "An employer or" and inserting the
following: 'In the absence of a policy that prohibits weapons at the employer's place of
business, an employer or'

SUMMARY

This amendment specifies that, in the absence of a policy prohibiting weapons at an
employer's place of business, an employer may not prohibit an employee from keeping a
firearm in that employee's locked vehicle
