1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §600 is enacted to read:
3	§600. Concealed firearms
4 5 6 7	An employer or an agent of an employer may not prohibit an employee who has a valid permit to carry a concealed firearm under Title 25, chapter 252 from keeping a firearm in the employee's vehicle as long as the vehicle is locked and the firearm is not visible.
8	SUMMARY
9 10 11	This bill provides that an employer may not prohibit an employee with a valid concealed firearms permit from keeping a firearm in the employee's vehicle as long as the vehicle is locked and the firearm is not visible.
