A schedule W drug that contains: 16 (1) Heroin (diacetylmorphine); 17 (2) Cocaine in the form of cocaine base and at the time of the offense the person 18 has one or more prior convictions for any offense under this chapter or for 19 engaging in substantially similar conduct to that of the Maine offenses under this 20 chapter in another jurisdiction. For the purposes of this paragraph, a person has 21 been convicted of an offense on the date the judgment of conviction was entered 22 by the court the quantity possessed is 7 to 14 grams; 23 (2-A) Cocaine in the form of cocaine base and the quantity possessed is 2 to 4 24 grams; 25 (3) Methamphetamine; 26 (4) Oxycodone; 27 (5) Hydrocodone; or 28 (6) Hydromorphone. 29 Violation of this paragraph is a Class C crime; 30 Sec. 2.
