1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2071, sub-§2, ¶A,** as enacted by PL 2003, c. 452, Pt. Q,
3 §46 and affected by Pt. X, §2, is amended to read:

4 A. An operator may not turn a vehicle, including merging into traffic and changing
5 lanes, without giving an appropriate signal if other traffic may be affected by that
6 movement.

7 **SUMMARY**

8 This bill amends the law regarding vehicle turning and signals by requiring that an
9 operator of a vehicle must use an appropriate signal when merging into traffic or
10 changing lanes.
