Rules adopted pursuant to this subsection are routine technical rules as defined by Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.
12 13 14	Sec. 2. Rulemaking. By April 1, 2012, the Department of Health and Human Services shall adopt routine technical rules as defined by the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A to implement Title 22, section 3174-QQ.
