SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 94,
L.D. 112, Bill, "An Act To Discourage Illegal Dumping in the State"

Amend the amendment in section 4 in §2264-A in subsection 2 by striking out all of
paragraph B (page 2, lines 16 to 20 in amendment)

Amend the amendment in section 4 in §2264-A in subsection 2 to reletter the
paragraphs to read consecutively.

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 6.

SUMMARY

This amendment strikes those provisions of Committee Amendment "A" that require
the court to suspend a person's motor vehicle operator's license and certain licenses,
permits, registrations and certificates issued by the Department of Inland Fisheries and
Wildlife for unlawfully disposing of more than 15 pounds of litter or more than 27 cubic
feet of litter and that authorize the surrender of those same licenses, permits, registrations
and certificates for smaller amounts of littering.
