

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 105, L.D. 123, Bill, "An Act To Assist Seasonal Entertainment Facilities with Public Safety Requirements"

Amend the bill in section 1 in the first paragraph in the 9th and 10th lines (page 1, lines 24 and 25 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "in existing commercial places of assembly that are open for no more than 50 days per calendar year" and inserting the following: 'in a commercial place of assembly existing on March 1, 2011 that is open for no more than 50 days per calendar year; this exemption must expire upon the transfer by sale or otherwise of the ownership of the commercial place of assembly'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the automatic sprinkler system exemption in the bill applies to those commercial places of assembly in existence as of March 1, 2011 and specifies that the exemption expires upon the transfer of ownership of the commercial place of assembly.
