COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 108, L.D. 126, Bill, "An Act To Allow a Person with One Arm To Possess Certain Kinds of Prohibited Knives"

Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of subsection 3 (page 1, lines 3 and 4 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

'3. Notwithstanding subsection 1, a person who has only one arm may possess and transport a knife described under subsection 1 that has a blade 3 inches or less in length.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment mirrors the exception in 15 United States Code, Section 1244, which authorizes a person with one arm to possess and transport a dangerous knife that has a blade 3 inches or less in length.
