3 4	3. This section does not apply to the possession or transportation of a knife under subsection 1 by an individual who has only one arm.

6 7 8 9	This bill provides an exception to the prohibition against possession of a knife that has a blade that opens automatically by hand pressure or that has a blade that opens, falls or is ejected into position for an individual who has only one arm, based on a federa exemption.
