COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 117, L.D. 135, Bill, "An Act To Allow the Placement of Certain Road Signs That Advertise a Small Business"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Allow Placement of Certain Road Signs That Advertise a Business'

Amend the bill in section 3 in paragraph J in the first line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "that employs fewer than 10 persons"
