**Resolve, To Direct the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife
To Add One or More Moose Hunting Seasons in Wildlife
Management District No. 8**

1 **Emergency preamble. Whereas,** acts and resolves of the Legislature do not
2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

3 **Whereas,** this legislation requires the amending of rules for moose hunting in time
4 for the next hunting season; and

5 **Whereas,** in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within
6 the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as
7 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
8 therefore, be it

9 **Sec. 1. Expanded moose hunting season. Resolved:** That the Commissioner
10 of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall amend the rules for Wildlife Management District
11 No. 8 to add one or more 6-day moose hunting seasons for the district in addition to the
12 one 6-day season already established by rule; and be it further

13 **Sec. 2. Adopted rules. Resolved:** That rules adopted pursuant to this resolve are
14 routine technical rules as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375,
15 subchapter 2-A.

16 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this
17 legislation takes effect when approved.

18 **SUMMARY**

19 This resolve directs the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to amend the
20 rules for Wildlife Management District No. 8 to add one or more 6-day moose hunting
21 seasons to the one 6-day season already established by rule.
